ADOPTED FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT AMENDMENT ORDINANCE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a Tallmadge Charter Township Floodplain Management Amendment Ordinance was adopted at a meeting of the Tallmadge Charter Township Board held on October 11, 2011 after its first reading at a meeting of the Tallmadge Charter Township Board held on September 13, 2011.

The Floodplain Management Amendment Ordinance will amend Ordinance No. 030811-2 to affirm the township as an enforcing agency; amend Ordinance No. 81280 as amended by Ordinance No. 812A83, to designate flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of PA 1972.

The following Floodplain Management Amendment Ordinance was adopted at the Tallmadge Charter Township Board meeting on October 11, 2011.

ORDINANCE NO. 091311-1

FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT AMENDMENT ORDINANCE

An ordinance amendment to Ordinance No. 030811-2 to affirm an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Charter Township of Tallmadge located in Ottawa County; and an ordinance amendment to Ordinance No. 81280, as amended by Ordinance No. 812A83, to designate flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF TALLMADGE ORDAINS:

Section 1 **Agency Designated.** Section 1 of Ordinance No. 030811-2 is restated in its entirety as follows.

- A. Pursuant to the provisions of the State Construction Code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended (the "Act"), the Township is designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the Township's responsibility under the Act. The enforcement agency or the building official (or both) obligated to discharge the Township's responsibilities under the Act shall be designated from time to time by Township Board resolution.
- B. Pursuant to the provisions of the State Construction Code, including the Michigan Building Code and the Michigan Residential Code, the Township assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of the Act, including Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code, throughout the Township's geographical limits.
- C. The fees for Michigan Building Code or Michigan Residential Code permits and the required inspections shall be established from time to time by Township Board resolution.

Section 2 **Designation of Regulated Flood Prone Hazard Areas.** Section 3.2 of Ordinance No. 81280, as amended by Ordinance No. 812A83, is restated in its entirety as follows.

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled 'Ottawa County, Michigan (All Jurisdictions)' and dated December 16, 2011 and the Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) panel numbers of 26139C; 0143E, 0144E, 0165E, 0175E, 0232E, 0234E, 0255E, 0258E and 0266E and dated December 16, 2011 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Residential Code, and declared to be part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code, and to provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Code. The FIS and FIRM shall be kept on file at the

Tallmadge Township Hall at 0-1451 Leonard Avenue, N.W., Grand Rapids, Michigan.

Section 3 Repeals.

All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4 Effective Date.

This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board on October 11, 2011, after introduction and a first reading on September 13, 2011, and publication after such first reading as required by Public Act 359 of 1947, as amended. This Ordinance shall be effective on November 17, 2011, which date is at least 30 days after publication of this Ordinance.
